

Completion Report: Awareness Session on Inclusive Education

Overview

The Awareness Session on Inclusive Education was held on 16th and 17th September 2024 at KRC Non-Formal Schools, engaging 20 boys and 14 girls. The initiative aimed to promote equality in education and ensure learning opportunities for all children, particularly within the Rohingya community.













Key Activities (The session included)

- 1. **Motivational Talks**: Inspiring students with the value of education and its role in shaping futures.
- 2. **Workshops**: Interactive discussions to build awareness of inclusive education practices.
- 3. **Sports Activities**: Engaging indoor games to foster teamwork, inclusion, and enthusiasm for learning.
