

Completion Report:

Parents Awareness Workshop on Girls' Education, Child Marriage, and Dowry

Organized by: Student Union for Rohingya Development (SURD)

Overview

In the 2nd week of October 2024, SURD conducted a Parents Awareness Workshop on Girls' Education, Child Marriage, and Dowry in the Kutupalong Registered Camp and Camp 4. The workshop engaged 25 male and female adults and 10 older participants, focusing on building awareness and encouraging community action against these critical social challenges.



Key Activities (The workshop included)

- 1. **Interactive Discussions**: Addressing the importance of girls' education and its role in community development.
- 2. **Awareness Sessions**: Highlighting the physical, emotional, and social harms caused by child marriage and dowry practices.
- 3. **Strategic Engagement:** Sharing actionable steps for parents to support education and reject harmful traditions.







Outcomes and Impact

- ✓ Increased Awareness:

 Participants gained a deeper understanding of the issues and expressed a commitment to change.
- ✓ Community Advocacy:

 Many attendees pledged
 to advocate for girls'
 education and
 discourage child
 marriage and dowry in
 their community circles.



Challenges Encountered (The session faced several obstacles, including)

- 1. **Cultural Resistance**: Some participants initially hesitated to accept the concepts due to deep-rooted traditions.
- 2. **Skepticism About Change**: A few individuals doubted the feasibility of addressing such long-standing practices.
- 3. **Limited Literacy Levels**: Explaining complex issues required additional effort to ensure comprehension.

Through open dialogue, real-life examples, and relatable narratives, these challenges were addressed, fostering a supportive and interactive environment.

Future Plans

SURD aims to extend its efforts by engaging more families and integrating broader strategies to tackle child marriage and dowry practices while promoting girls' education as a pillar of community empowerment.
